

Comments

- A desk will be identified at the front of the classroom where a student who needs a comment will place their planner allowing social distancing from the teacher. The member of staff can enter the comment and then hand sanitise immediately afterwards.
- Students will be provided with necessary equipment by the form tutor each day which will minimise the movement of students and reduce equipment comments.
- Students who are not social distancing with students outside of their pod and are deliberately too close to each other for a sustained period of time will receive a comment – this needs to be central to staff training.
- If a student receives a phase 3 they will remain in their current seat within the classroom.

Phase 4

- Phase 4 will be timetabled by leadership within the year group bubble
- An identified desk in each Phase 4 classroom will support students moving to Phase 4

Detentions

- Detentions will be run twice per week (Monday and Wednesday) per year group on an identified day which will be shared with staff. They will be run in year group bubbles in an identified classroom.
- Cumulative detentions will lead to Head Teacher detention as opposed to isolation.
- Detentions will be recorded directly into SIMS by staff to remove the circulation of detention slips

Head Teacher Detentions

- Head Teacher Detentions will need to run in Year Group bubbles in an identified classroom each week. Failure to attend/ complete Head Teacher detention will result in Isolation

Isolation

- Failed Phase 4 results in a student finishing the rest of the day in Isolation
- The tariff of behaviour incidents leading to isolation remains the same
- Isolation will run for only 1 full day and Period 7. If there are 2 incidents that warrant isolation then the student will serve a day for each incident.
- The implementation of the support pyramid for pastoral staff is key to support identified students and work with families

Exclusion

- The tariff of behaviour incidents leading to exclusion remains the same. The following behaviour incidents have been added which warrant exclusion:
 1. Spitting will be a 5 day exclusion
 2. Intimidating another person by a deliberate break of social distancing/ Covid-19 guidance will be a 5 day exclusion
- CLA/ EHCP/ high need SEMH students who reach exclusion will be supported with internal exclusion.
- All exclusions signed off by API
- No support exclusions

Buses

- There will be a register for each bus
- Students will be allocated a seat on the bus and will sit in year group pods
- Students will be expected to follow latest Gov guidance on the bus
- Students who do not comply with Gov guidance will be dealt with in line with PD. Repeat offenders will be banned from the bus.

Parents/ Carers

- Parents/ carers will only be allowed on site by appointment only and this will be beyond the school day when students have gone home. Staff will endeavour to hold parent meetings over the phone where possible.

Toilets

- Students will be allowed to go to the toilet during lessons. APL & Mark Newman to finalise a simple system to monitor this

PE Kit

- Students who do not have correct PE kit will be given a detention
